

AEP-Kenya Opens Office in Nairobi

Africa Education Project-Kenya kicked off the new year in style with the opening of an office on January 1, 2006.

Since the organization's founding in September 2003, AEP-Kenya has had transient offices in staff homes mainly consisting of a collection of AEP-Kenya files. Staff meetings were frequently held in area restaurants. In the early days, it was more important for AEP-Kenya to invest money in its programs rather than office rental. The growth of AEP-Kenya has made it necessary for the organization to open an office to make operations more efficient and effective.

The AEP-Kenya office will be a centralized place for AEP-Kenya staff, Board of Directors, volunteers and scholars to meet. The AEP office based on the United States donated two laptop computers to AEP-Kenya to get its operations started.

“This is a sign that AEP-Kenya is growing and maturing as an organization,” reports William Siwa, Program Coordinator for AEP-Kenya.
